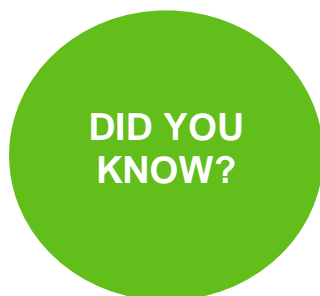

Raising Attainment in Reading Comprehension: 'Inference Training'

A **one day** course to equip practitioners to implement a group intervention to raise pupil attainment in inferential comprehension, as well as applying the key intervention principles and strategies in the classroom context

'Inference Training' is a research-based **group intervention for KS2 and KS3 pupils with a focus on teaching reading comprehension** delivered by teachers or teaching assistants. This intervention programme supports **accelerated pupil progress by an average of 12 months progress** in comprehension over a period of 10 weeks.
